

Financial Disclosure

As a newly established 501c3 public charity we do not have previous documented financial history. The dogs of Otavalo project work that was done in Ecuador in April of 2017 was funded through other 501c3 agencies and all charitable contributions were made to those agencies. The previous children's projects were supported entirely by individual contributions and volunteers.

Going forward in the establishment of eagleYcondor charitable projects and campaigns, we will fully disclose all charitable contributions and the goods and services for which those funds are allocated. We will be completely transparent in our record keeping and our funding resources. Organizational & Financial Information

Legally Incorporated: The eagleycondor Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation provide details on how our organization is structured and managed.

Tax Exempt: We are recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as tax-exempt organization. The IRS Determination Letter (501c3 determination) confirms this information.

Volunteer Governance: Our Board of Directors provides internal oversight to the organization:

Funds donated for Los Peluditos de Ecuador will be used for the

- 1) purchase of drugs, surgical and medical supplies to be used strictly during spay/neuter/wellness clinics in Ecuador
- 2) housing and feeding of volunteer veterinarians, technicians and assistants during campaigns in Ecuador
- 3) shipping of supplies from US to Ecuador
- 4) transportation of volunteers in Ecuador.

Funds for Los Niños de Mojandita will be used for

- 1) art and music supplies
- 2) housing and feeding of volunteer teachers and assistants
- 3) transportation of additional baggage of supplies with volunteers

- 4) transportation of volunteers while assisting in Ecuadorian school programs
- 5) minor repairs within host schools in Ecuador for the safety and wellbeing of students therein

A small percentage of donated funds will be allocated for legal expenses, promotional materials used for fundraising and website maintenance costs and fundraising events.

Additional costs will include the building of safe provisional housing of all supplies, medical and educational in Ecuador, to be warehoused for future campaigns.
